EVALUATION OF SCHOOL BOARD OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES

The following elements are included in the self-evaluation process:

- 1. Essex County School Board members are involved in the development of an evaluation instrument and procedure.
- 2. The Essex County School Board's evaluation instrument is completed by individual Essex County School Board members and submitted to the Essex County School Board Chairman, or the Chairman's designee, for compilation.
- 3. The Essex County School Board meets, with all members present, to review and discuss the composite results.
- 4. Each conclusion is supported by objective evidence.

Based on discussion of the results, the Essex County School Board develops both short- and long-range goals and objectives to ensure continued proficiency in its areas of excellence, to strengthen weak areas and to improve the efficiency of the board.
